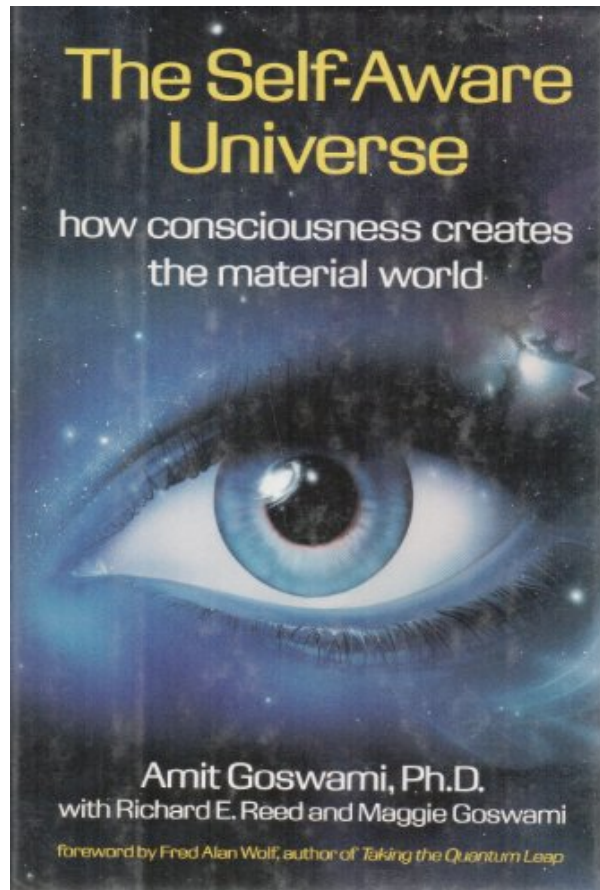
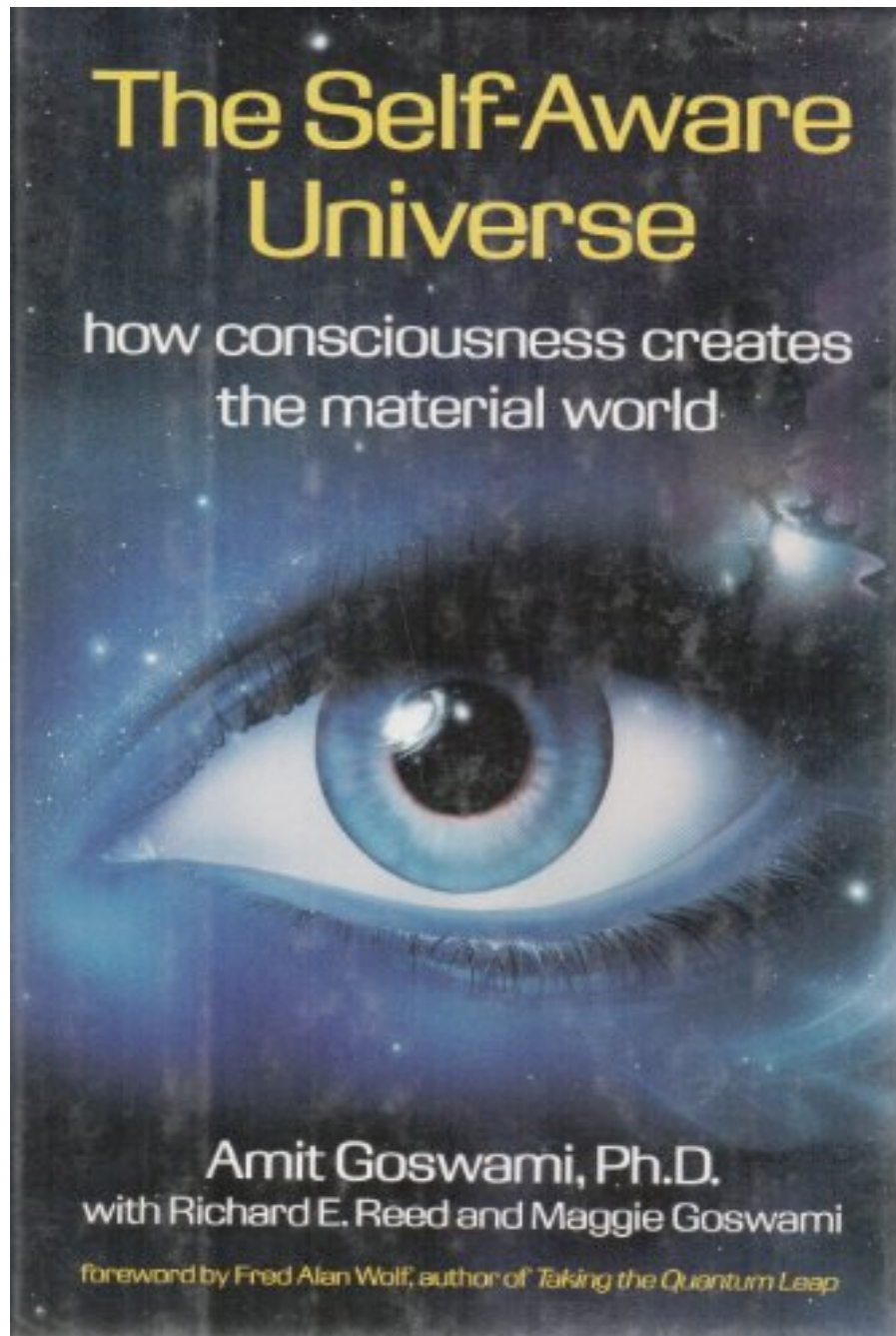

Dr. Goswami combines science with philosophy to convincingly show that the foundations of modern empirical science need a major overhaul. He links the paradoxes of quantum physics with the philosophy of idealism... the idea that everything is build of Mind and Consciousness. In the process, he demonstrates that the paradoxes of quantum physics dissolve when we leave the philosophy or objective materialism behind. We come to see the materialistic viewpoint as a powerful model that lets us know something about the local world around us, but which fails when dealing with either the very small, or the cosmically large. When we realize that objective materialism requires "locality", that is, that there can be no "spooky action at a distance" in Einstein's words, we also realize that matter and energy cannot be the basic building blocks of the universe. Goswami invites us to begin perceiving the Universe as a construct of Mind, in which we participate. An astoundingly good book.
